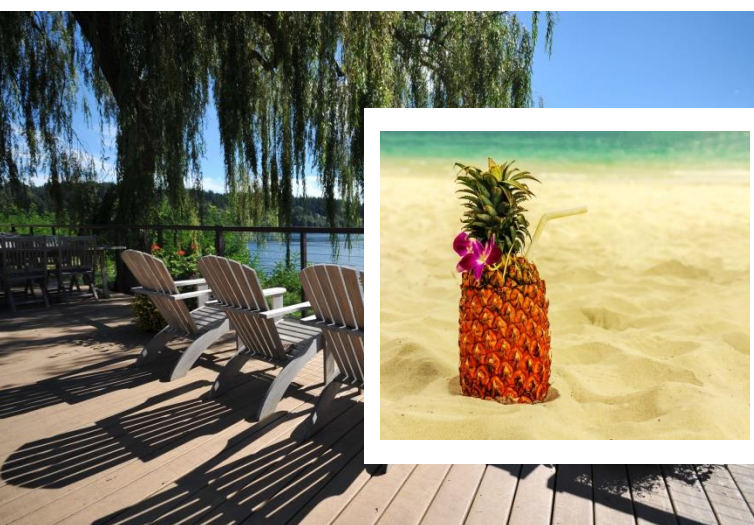

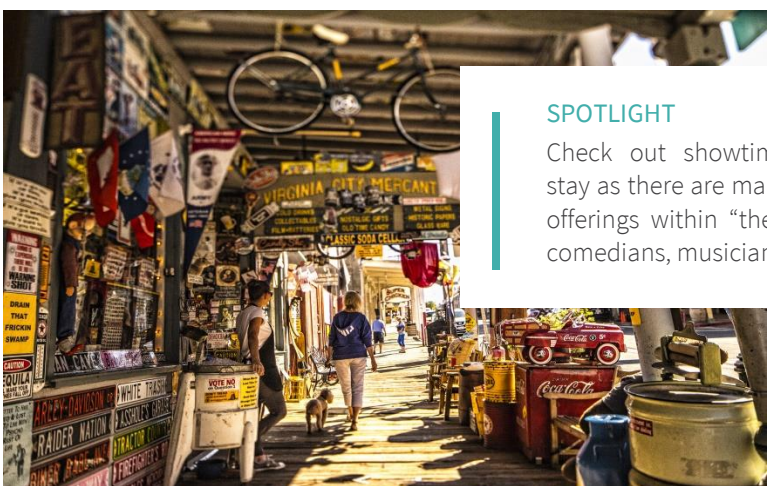

The Royal Tyrrell Museum is Canada's only museum dedicated exclusively to the study of ancient life. It houses the world's largest selection of dinosaurs with hundreds of thousands of fossils and a magnitude of reconstructed displays.

Heritage Park provides an immersive experience that connects people with the settlement of Western Canada. The living Historical Village depicts life from the 1860s through the 1930s.



DID YOU KNOW?

Hoodoos are formed through a repetitive process of freezing, melting, erosion and wind. Drumheller's hoodoos are said to be 70 to 75 million years old.
