





Old Quebec is the most intact fortified town and walled city north of Mexico. It was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1985 and has retained its colonial architecture for over 400 years. Bask in its European charm as you explore the birthplace of French in North America and expect to be awed as you travel back in time.





ITINERARY




