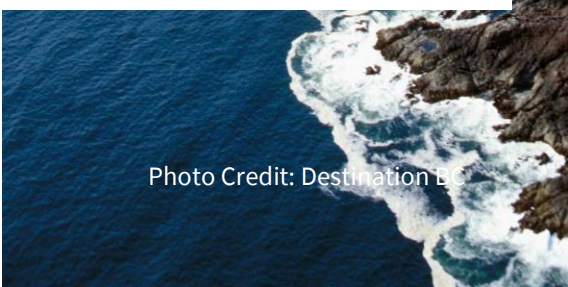

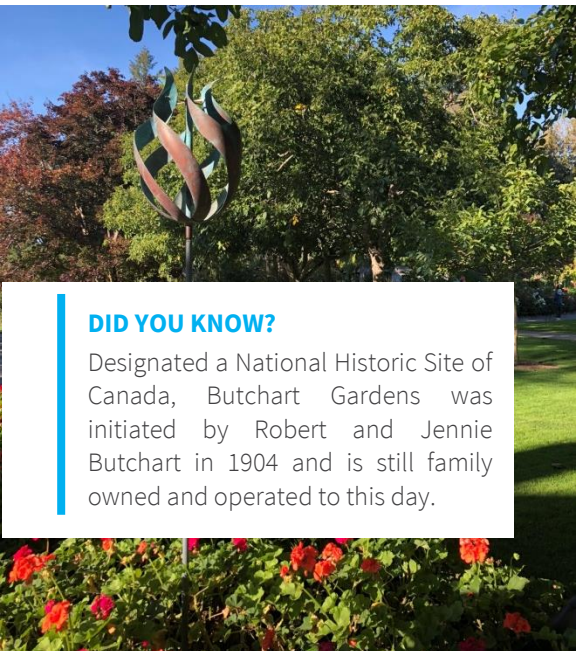

Designated a National Historic Site of Canada, Butchart Gardens was initiated by Robert and Jennie Butchart in 1904 and is still family owned and operated to this day.
